Brecon Foodbank statistics to the end of 2023.



Brecon Foodbank opened in July 2014. Since then we have given out 4470 food parcels. We have fed 10552 people, comprising 6489 adults and 4063 children. We have been given 127,024.67kg food & toiletries and have given out 126,212.3kg food & toiletries.

In 2022 we gave out 810 food parcels. We fed 2215

people, comprising 1292 adults and 923 children. We were given 19,079.1kg and purchased 4,493.3kg, which totalled (with 52.45kg returns) 23,487.85kg food & toiletries. and gave out 24,869kg food & toiletries. This was an increase of 213 parcels and 740 people fed compared to 2021, so we gave out 6,001.5kg more stock.

In 2023 we gave out 959 food parcels. We fed 2281 people, comprising 1396 adults and 885 children. We were given 16,750.25kg and purchased 9,734.75kg, which totalled (with 148.25kg returns) 26,633.25kg food & toiletries. This is a decrease in donations of food & toiletries, and an increase in the amount we needed to purchase. We gave out 25,640.55kg food & toiletries. This was an increase of 149 parcels and 66 people fed compared to 2022, (104 more adults but 38 fewer children) so we gave out 793.9.5kg more stock.

In December 2023 we gave out 207 food parcels, feeding 518 people comprising 307 adults and 211 children. (This is the same number of parcels but 48 fewer people than in December 2022: 6 more adults but 54 fewer children .) This includes 91 'Christmas Extras' bags feeding and giving gifts for 128 adults and 103 children, a total of 231 people. The food part of the Christmas 'extras' bags totalled 484.35kg Christmas food, plus vouchers for fruit and vegetables, and a butcher's voucher.
